Trash Cans

- Retrieve cart from curb by midnight on your pickup day
- Bulk pickup is every 2nd Tuesday of the month

All containers for trash disposal must not be visible to a person standing in the street, not just directly in front of the residence.



Trees in park strips are resident responsibility

Trees in the parkways and alleyways are the responsibility of the homeowners. However, limbs or issues affecting streets or public areas can be handled by the City.

Oversized Trucks

No commercial vehicles, RVs or trailers can be parked on the street or driveways.

Park Place considers these vehicles an obstruction of sight on our small, crowded streets. Safety is a primary concern for our residents.



Sidewalks are not the City of Fort Worth's responsibility

Fort Worth puts the obligation for the repair, replacement and maintenance of sidewalk, parkways, driveways and approaches on the owner of the affected property. If homeowners don't maintain the sidewalk in front of their property, they can be cited for a misdemeanor under city ordinance.

Vehicles must never block driveways.



Fencing

- Fencing should be neat and maintained in appearance
- No leaning or missing slats



Landscaping

- Maintain the property in a neat and attractive manner
- Grass should not be taller than 6 inches
- Shrubs should be maintained and trimmed
- Landscaping to cover the foundation across the front of the residence
